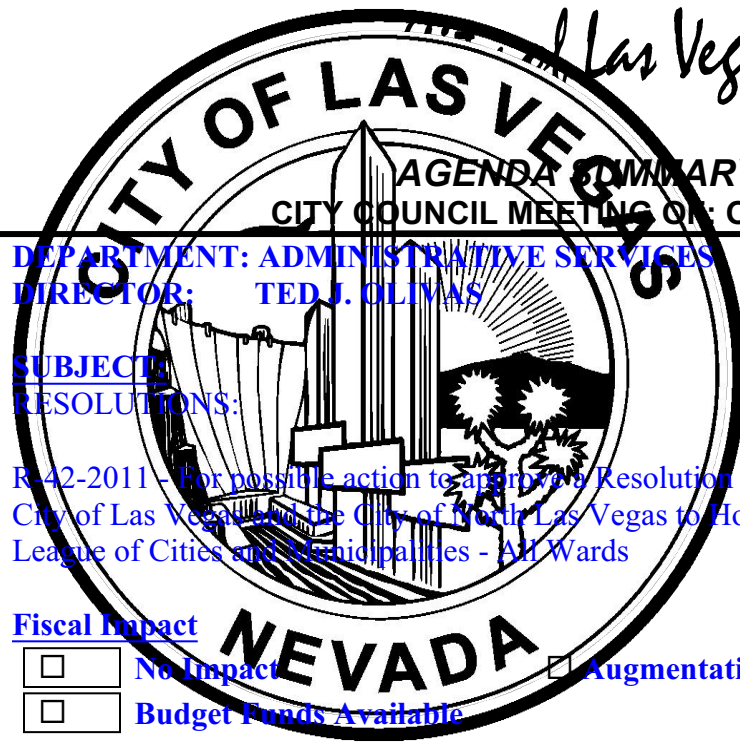

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Nevada League of Cities & Municipalities (NLC&M) has 24 member municipalities that include all of the incorporated cities, as well as some unincorporated towns and general improvement districts. The membership represents very diverse communities around the state from the City of Wells, to Incline Village, to Boulder City, to the largest City of Las Vegas. The purposes of the NLC&M are to foster periodic conferences or meetings of member municipal officials for the discussion of municipal problems and for the purpose of promoting governmental efficiency. The NLC&M hosts one major annual conference each year, bringing together all of Nevada's elected officials and key administrative staff in an educational environment with topics covering current and emerging issues and technologies. This conference provides a wide variety of educational and training opportunities for municipal officials and carries out organizational business for the discussion of municipal problems.
