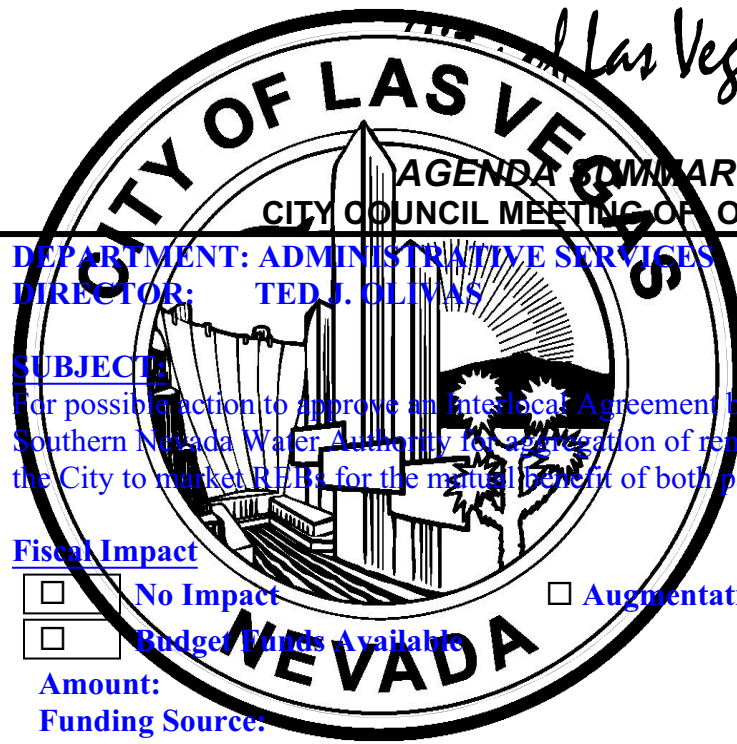

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The City of Las Vegas and the Southern Nevada Water Authority (SNWA) have both been leaders in installing renewable energy systems within their respective jurisdictions which have resulted in the accumulation of renewable energy benefits (REBs). Previous actions by the City Council under the Climate Protection Resolution (R-57-2006) and the Sustainable Energy Strategy (R-50-2008) have lead to the construction and installation of approximately five megawatts of renewable energy in the City of Las Vegas alone. Under the proposed Agreement, the Southern Nevada Water Authority, or its authorized reporting entity, will provide services to aggregate, market, and sell renewable energy benefits that the City of Las Vegas owns, generates and maintains.
