Project Descriptions:

1. Floyd Lamb Park at Tule Springs - Trail Access

The Floyd Lamb Park Master Plan adopted by the City in April 2007 was primarily created to define a preferred site plan alternative. Shown on the Master Plan are two environmental enhancement areas (EEA's) containing approximately four miles of trails that are currently being constructed at Floyd Lamb Park at Tule Springs with Clark County Regional Flood Control District (CCRFCD) and SNPLMA funding.

The City of Las Vegas is now seeking SNPLMA funding for trail access from the Brent Lane entrance to the EEA trails and further into the park core to existing trails leading in and around the historic area, lakes and picnic areas.

2. Children's Memorial Park Splash Pad Water Feature

The City of Las Vegas is requesting funding to provide a splash pad water feature at the Children's Memorial Park located at Gowan Road and Torrey Pines Drive. A water feature at this park would be an ideal location since existing parks that offer non-pool water features are 9-miles apart leaving a vastly underserved area for this type of feature.
