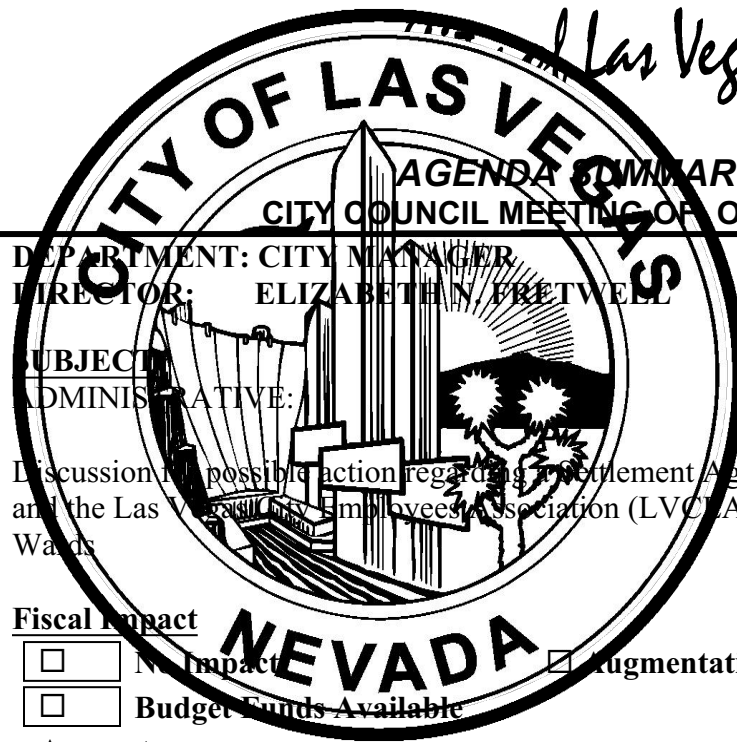

The City of Las Vegas will go dark (close) the week of December 26, 2011. The plant closure will settle a dispute between the City of Las Vegas and the Las Vegas City Employees Association (LVCEA). Essential public safety functions such as Fire & Rescue, City Marshal services including animal control, parking enforcement and the jail, and sewage plant operations will continue as normal.
