Minutes:

FLINN FAGG, Director of Planning, reviewed the background of the case and submitted for the record a letter from the employer stating the applicant will only be working on fire sprinkler systems and not burglar alarm systems.

HORACE SMITH, President of Total Safety Inc, stated his full confidence in the applicant whose work history is outstanding.

COUNCILMAN ROSS stated that MR. SMITH is an outstanding member of our community and such a high recommendation from him speaks volumes.

MR. SMITH clarified for COUNCILMAN BARLOW that the applicant will not have any access to databases, customer information or any duties connected with burglar alarm systems.

COUNCILMAN ANTHONY received clarification from MR. FAGG that the only reason for the work card application is because of organizational changes. He also confirmed that MR. SMITH stated for the record that the applicant will only work on sprinkler systems and stipulated that a one year review will be conducted by the Planning Department.
