Prior to beginning the ceremonial portion of the Agenda, MAYOR GOODMAN congratulated COUNCILMAN BARLOW on the birth of his daughter on Tuesday, November 1, 2011.

The Mayor announced WILL and THERESA FAISS are being honored as the Citizens of the Month. She asked MR. FAISS to the podium (MRS. FAISS was unable to attend).
