Minutes:

COUNCILMAN ROSS announced the upcoming Veterans Day Parade scheduled for Friday, November 11, 2011. Over 40,000 spectators are expected to attend.

BILLY STOJACK, Veterans Day Parade Committee Co-Chairman, is honored that singing legend, PAT BOON, volunteered to kick off the parade for free. There will also be a flyover of a B-1 Bomber from Nellis Air Force Base at 11:11 a.m. and more than 131 entrants that include 17 Reserve Officers Training Corps (ROTC) and the 200th Marching Band. The parade is being billed as the largest Veterans Day Parade west of the Mississippi. He introduced LEONARD WENSON, Veterans Day Parade Committee Co-Chairman and Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1753 Commander, TERRY REVELLA, Parade Marshal, and E. S. NOISE, secretary and veteran. He thanked the City for their cooperation and recognized his go-to lady, ESTHER CARTER.

COUNCILMAN ROSS stated there are tremendous amounts of youth participating in the event and hopes the community will support them. He then presented MR. STOJACK with a proclamation.

MAYOR GOODMAN stated they always walk in support of the veterans and this year she will be handing out flags as they walk through the parade.
