PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Traffic Engineering Division received a request to install speed humps on Arlington Avenue between Torrey Pines Drive and Hussey Drive. Studies conducted on this street showed that the 85th percentile speed was 35 mph and the volume of traffic was 247 vehicles per day. A total of 40 points is recommended for the installation of speed humps, and Arlington Avenue accumulated 13 points. This street is not an emergency response route.
