

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE SAHARA WEST
WALKABLE COMMUNITY PLAN**

WHEREAS, policies within the Las Vegas 2020 Master Plan direct the City to review existing neighborhoods for opportunities to include design elements such as enhanced pedestrian crossings, pedestrian lighting and removal of impediments in order to promote walkability; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to implement those policies by reviewing a number of neighborhoods, in each case with a view towards adopting a plan to promote walkability within that neighborhood, where appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the Sahara West Walkable Community Plan has been developed to focus on the neighborhood generally located within a half-mile radius of the intersection of Sahara Avenue and Fort Apache Road; and

WHEREAS, the Sahara West Walkable Community Plan is intended to serve as a guiding document designed to offer walkable components to enhance existing community amenities within that neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the Sahara West Walkable Community Plan is scheduled for consideration by the City Council at the afternoon session of its November 16, 2011, meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS to adopt the Sahara West Walkable Community Plan as approved by the City Council on November 16, 2011.
