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GENERAL PURPOSE: Service learning program designed to encourage middle and high school youth to take an active role in their community. Youth and adults will serve side-by-side and select exemplary proposals for funding. Board reviews YNAPP applications and recommends awards to the City Council. Service learning grants are offered to registered neighborhood association youth groups for neighborhood and community improvement projects.

AUTHORITY: Created by City Council action on 3-1-2000 and members appointed on 5-3-2000. By-laws adopted 3-1-2000. By-Laws Amended by City Council on 11-5-2003; By-Laws Amended by City Council on 10-7-2009 (changes creating alternate representatives, setting quorum and procedural changes).

TERMS: ONE-YEAR TERM - May be reappointed to consecutive one-year terms.

Must fill un-expired term - Membership is not transferable or assignable.
Board expires yearly on date specified by the City (11-5-2003 Council action, amended By-Laws).

MEMBERS: 15 members and 2 alternates appointed by the Mayor and City Council as follows:

Mayor	Two (2) Adult Designees Seven (7) Youth Designees from geographically diverse locations One (1) Adult Alternate and One (1) Youth Alternate
Council	One (1) Adult Designee from each of the six Council Wards
