PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Assembly Bill 511 of the 2011 Session of the Nevada Legislature requires local governments to establish a program by which the operator of a qualified alternative fuel vehicle generally may park the vehicle without the payment of a parking fee at certain times in public parking lots, parking areas and metered parking zones. This bill will establish such a program, including the processes and standards by which it will be implemented.
