PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

For many years City licensing regulations (and later zoning regulations as well) have prohibited Class III jewelry stores, pawnshops and secondhand dealers from locating on Las Vegas Boulevard between Charleston Boulevard and Sahara Avenue. A similar prohibition exists for Fremont Street. It is believed that such prohibitions were based on a historical view of what types of development along those corridors should include. It has been proposed by means of this bill to remove the prohibition regarding Las Vegas Boulevard.

This bill should be submitted to a Recommending Committee for review, hearing and recommendation to the City Council for final action.
