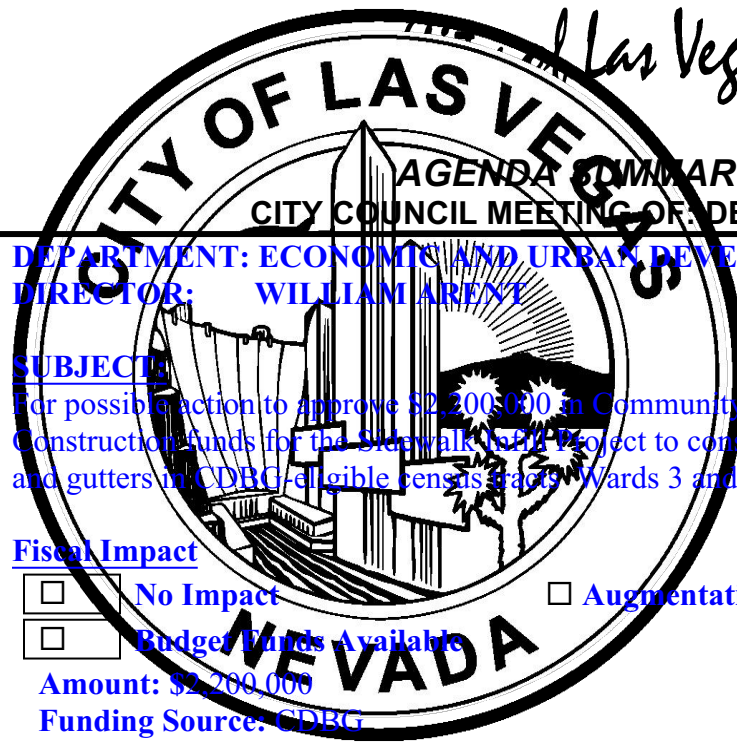

For possible action to approve \$2,200,000 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Construction funds for the Sidewalk Infill Project to construct sidewalks with ADA ramps, curbs and gutters in CDBG-eligible census tracts Wards 3 and 5 (Coffin and Barlow)

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Sidewalk Infill Project will increase safety and improve residents overall quality of life by repairing and replacing broken/damaged sidewalks and installing new sidewalks with ADA ramps, curbs and gutters where there are currently none. The Project will encompass two separate areas referred to as Areas 1 and 6. Area 1, located in Ward 3, is bound by Charleston Boulevard to the south, Interstate 515 to the north, Las Vegas Boulevard to the west, and Bruce Street to the east. Area 6, located in Ward 5, is bound by Bonanza Road to the south, Owens Avenue to the north, Martin Luther King Boulevard to the west, and Interstate 15 to the east.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the allocation of CDBG funding for the Sidewalk Infill construction costs and authorize the Directors of Economic and Urban Development and Public Works Departments to sign the Memorandum of Understanding after approval by the City Attorney.
