Minutes:

Prior to hearing this item, MAYOR PRO TEM ANTHONY recognized the Student Council from Paul Colley Elementary who were attending the meeting with their faculty advisor, JESSICA KITCHENS. The Councilman recalled a recent visit by MAYOR GOODMAN to the school and told the students that TED OLIVAS, Director of Administrative Services, is an alumnus of the school.

ANTHONY HODGES, Las Vegas resident, referenced Item 33 and asked if the pole was being removed to widen the street.

TODD FARLOW, Las Vegas resident, stated his opposition to Item 34 based on two reasons. Paving the bottoms of the channels not only destroys the plant life but also prevents plant life from filtering the water prior to it reaching the lake. He stated Item 36 is an excellent project and he hopes it receives everyone's support. COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN clarified that the paving is a water preservation method to help collect more water by preventing the ground from soaking it up.
