CHAIR TROWBRIDGE declared the Public Hearing open.

STEVE GEBEKE, Planning and Development, stated the sale of packaged liquor would be ancillary, so staff could support the request and recommended approval.

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ATTORNEY JUSTIN SMERBER, Moran Law Firm, 630 South 4th Street, appeared with JIM SANCHEZ and LESTER PAYLEE, on behalf of the applicant. ATTORNEY SMERBER noted that previously the site was a Vons grocery store. They believe the proper permits are in place and the proposed development is compatible with other stores in the community. COMMISSIONER TRUESDELL confirmed that the previous Vons had a liquor license.
