Minutes:

CHAIR TROWBRIDGE declared the Public Hearing open.

STEVE GEBEKE, Planning and Development, explained the applicant has submitted plans, which reflect the expansion area to be used as an additional storage area. Staff supported the

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request, including the waiver, as parking is shared with the adjacent property owner. The business has been in existence for three years and is compatible with the surrounding area. Staff recommended approval.

ATTORNEY MAREN PARRY, 100 North City Parkway, appeared on behalf of the applicants. Upon TODD FARLOWS, 240 North 19th Street, query, she informed him that shotguns and rifles are accepted, which will be stored on site but not sold. If a firearm is pawned, it is sent to an alcohol, tobacco and firearms licensed dealer.

COMMISSIONER QUINN visited the site and was amazed of the applicants organization of the items and the amount of space available. At her request, ATTORNEY KENNY ALLWEIN, 212 Las Vegas Boulevard, explained that the firearms are stored in a steel mesh safe on site.

CHAIR TROY BRIDGE declared the Public Hearing closed.
