CHAIR TROWBRIDGE declared the Public Hearing open.

DOUG RANKIN, Planning and Development Department, indicated this request is located within the same mixed-use establishment as indicated in Item 31. Staff supports the waiver of the park separation as the actual entrance to the park and this mixed-use project is over two miles away. Similar uses can be conducted in a compatible manner with the surrounding area. Staff recommended approval with an amendment to condition 1.
