Minutes:

CHAIR TROWBRIDGE declared the Public Hearing open.

FLINN FAGG, Planning and Development, summarized the changes proposed after the last
Planning Commission meeting. In terms of the configuration of the Small Wind Energy
Systems, a separation was made for parcels less than 20,000 square feet. It is required that the
Small Wind Energy Systems be mounted on the roof. For parcels over 20,000 square feet, they
can be mounted on the roof of the building or be a freestanding tower.

Relative to setbacks, under 20,000 square feet, it will follow the district setbacks. Over 20,000
square feet, the setbacks would be the greater of the district setback requirements or one times

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the tower's height from any occupied structures on adjacent properties.

Regarding the quantities of Small Wind structures permitted, one system would be permitted by right if they meet all the conditional use standards. Any additional Small Wind systems would require a special use permit application.

Language relative to the noise standard was made that the system must be installed and maintained at 60 decibels.

COMMISSIONER EVANS verified that COMMISSIONER TRUESDELL'S concerns have been incorporated into the revised document.

CHAIR TROWBRIDGE declared the Public Hearing closed.
