Minutes:

CHAIR TROWBRIDGE declared the Public Hearing open.

MARGO WHEELER, Director of Planning and Development, explained that when the Parkway Center was established, which includes the 61 acres and the outlet mall site, all liquor uses were not addressed and there is no opportunity for these types of uses to go forward. The proposal would allow beer, wine cooler, on-sale, beer, wine cooler off-sale, tavern, packaged liquor, off-sale restaurant with service bar, retail establishment all within a Special Use Permit, so that there would be the same allowance in the Parkway Center as it is elsewhere in the City. Staff recommended approval.
