On behalf of Verizon Wireless, I respectfully request your consideration of the attached Special Use Permit application. This project is located on parcel 162-03-112-002, a C-2 parcel in use as a self storage facility.

Verizon is proposing to add three antennas to the existing tower. Verizon currently has three flush mounted antennas on this tower. The additional antennas will also be flush mounted and painted to match the tower and existing antennas. The resulting Verizon antenna configuration will be six antennas. The three new antennas will be mounted so the over all height of the structure and antennas is not changed. The existing tower is owned by SBA Structures. Other carriers on this tower include Sprint, Clearwire and Cricket- all with full antenna arrays. Verizon is proposing to mount the new antennas in a flush mount style to maintain the current profile of the tower. Please see photo simulation for further illustration.

On September 11, 2009 a Site Development Review Application was submitted for this modification. On September 18th a letter from Planning was received stating the proposed modification could not be approved administratively and a Special Use Permit would be required.

This antenna modification will provide improved phone coverage for those working in and traveling through the Las Vegas Blvd. corridor to downtown. The modification will also bring new technology to subscribers with minimal visual impact to the tower and surrounding commercial area.
