Minutes:

CHAIR TROWBRIDGE declared the Public Hearing open.

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DOUG RANKIN, Planning and Development, stated that the square footage has been reduced to 1,669. The proposed major amendment is compatible with the surrounding area and meets Title 19 requirements. Staff recommended approval.

MR. RANKIN explained for COMMISSIONER TRUESDELL that because the revised square footage reflects more than a 10 percent reduction, a major amendment is required.
