

To whom this may concern,

I am making this application for a variance for a carport that I rebuilt. The carport that I replaced was very old and I felt that it would soon fall down. After I tore the old one down I needed footings for the new carport. I decided to redo my driveway because it had some vary bad cracks in it and I could do my footings at the same time. I built the new carport the same width as the old one. I made it longer then the old carport and I enhanced it some so I could house both my car and truck under it.

My driveway is 12' 9" and from the house to the property line is 13' 3". If I have to go by city code I would only have 7' 6" to park both my vehicles.

Most all the homes in this sub-division that are built on the width of their property that have a carport are all built right next to the property line, (see attached pictures). I just rode down a few streets and took the attached pictures. The carports seen in these pictures were built by the original contractor in the early 1960s.

I'm not sure this application is what you need but I sure hope so, and I would really appreciate you granting me the variance I'm asking for.
