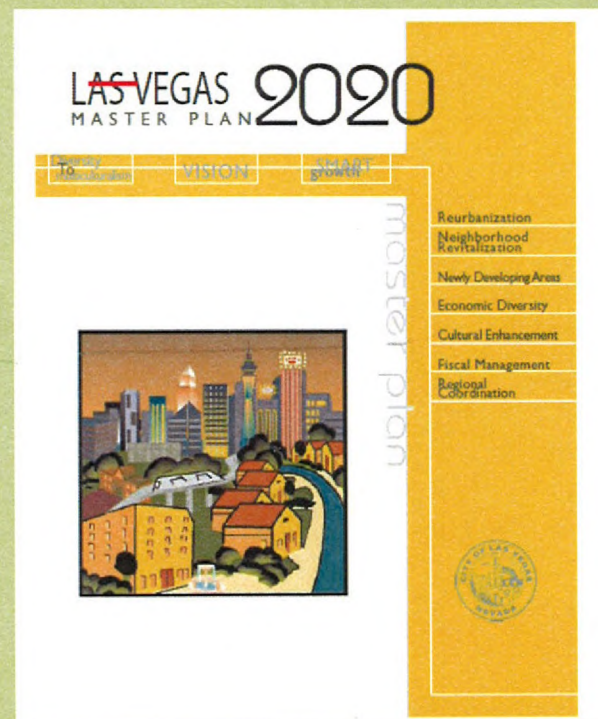

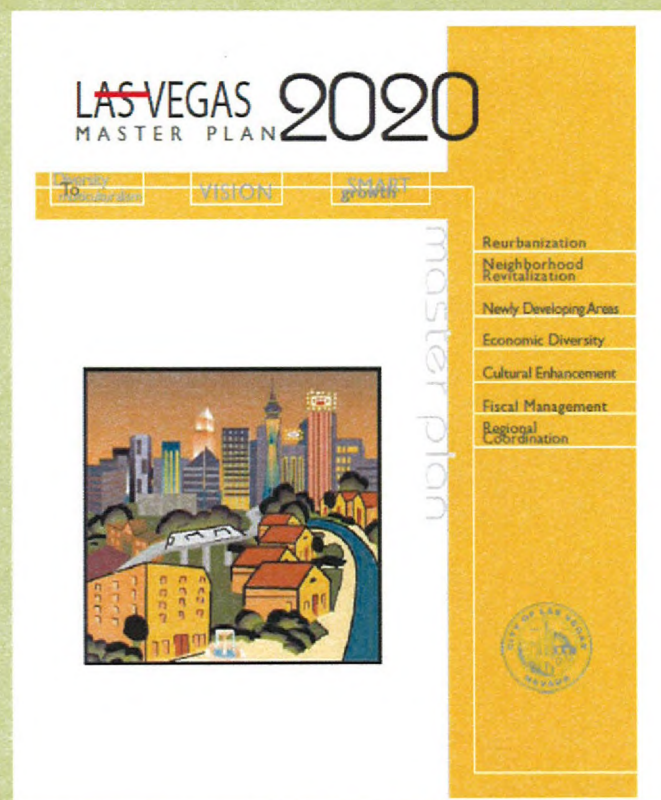
Master Plan 2020 Update

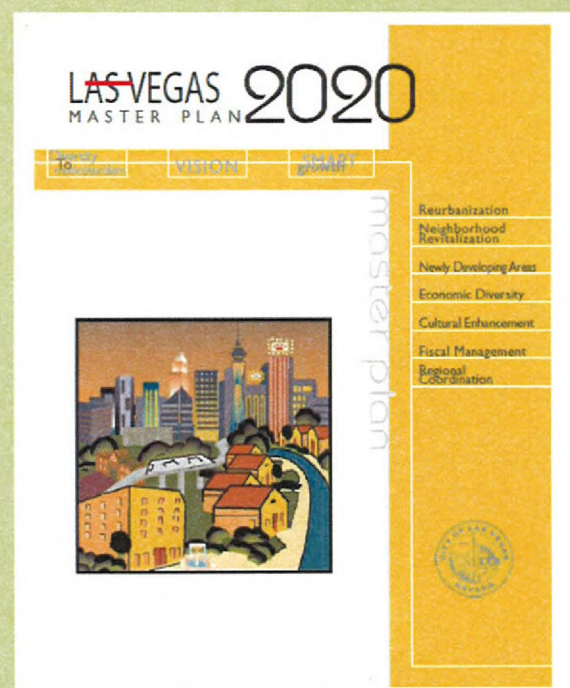
- ☐ Four Elements updated in the past year.

■ Within the next two months, the City Council will adopt the following elements, which were recently reviewed by the Planning Commission:

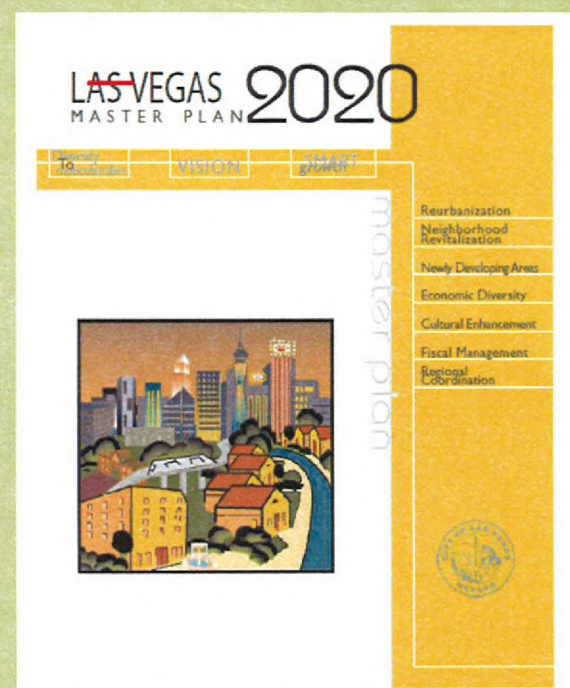

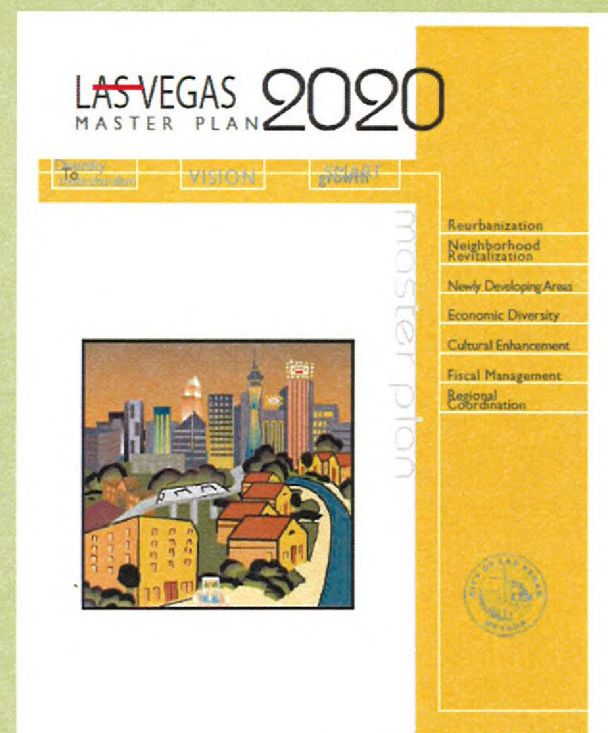
In the coming year the Planning Department will be adopting/updating the following elements in compliance with NRS:

- Water Element



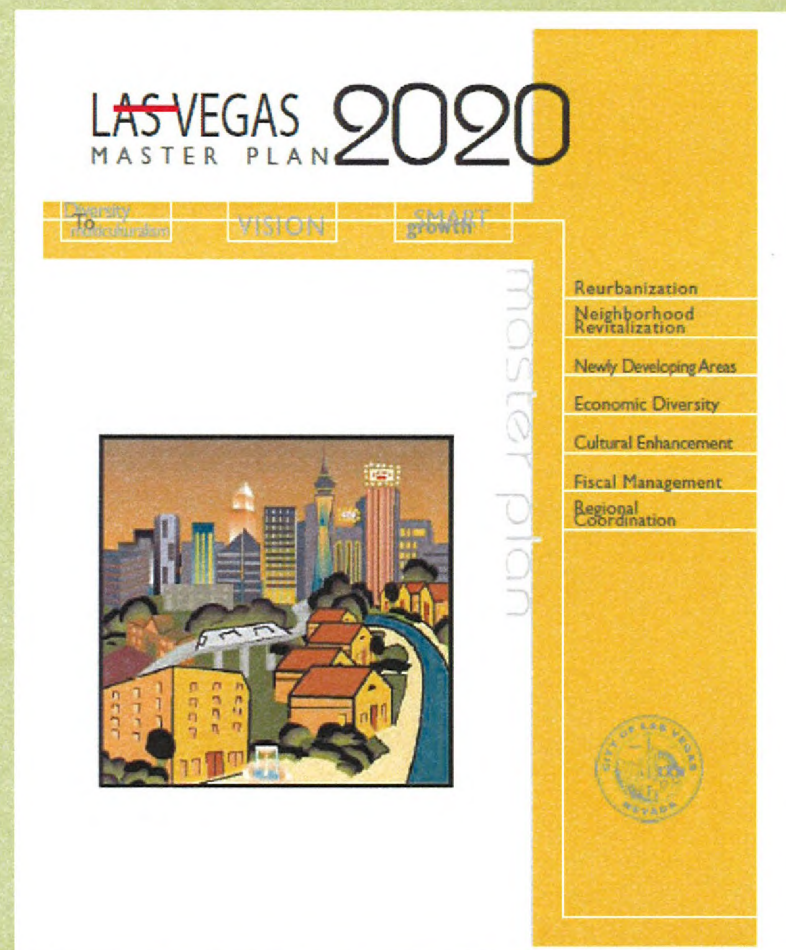
Master Plan 2020 - Accomplishments

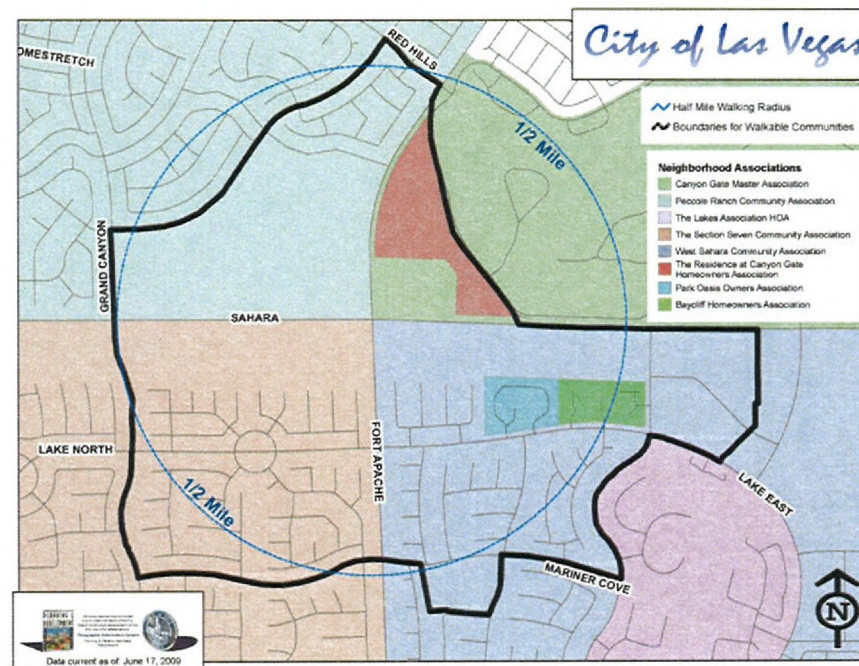

- Minimal turnout



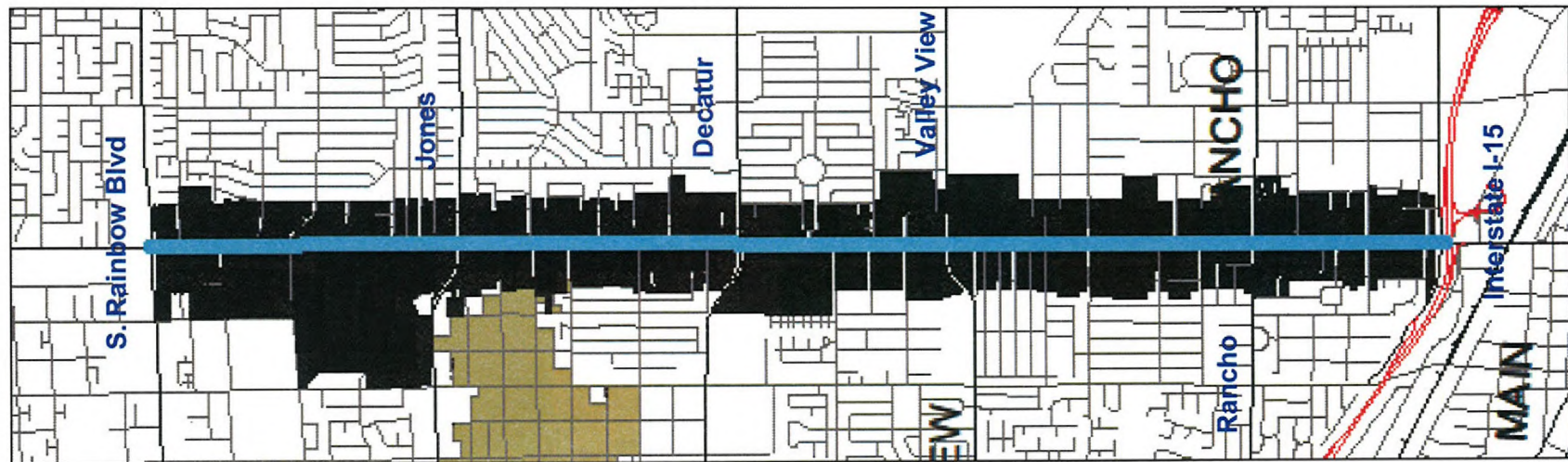
Corridor/Walkable Community Plans

- Outreach plan – Neighborhood Association meetings
- Attended 14 meetings in April/May 2010
- Attended 2 neighborhood events
- Distributed flyers to local businesses



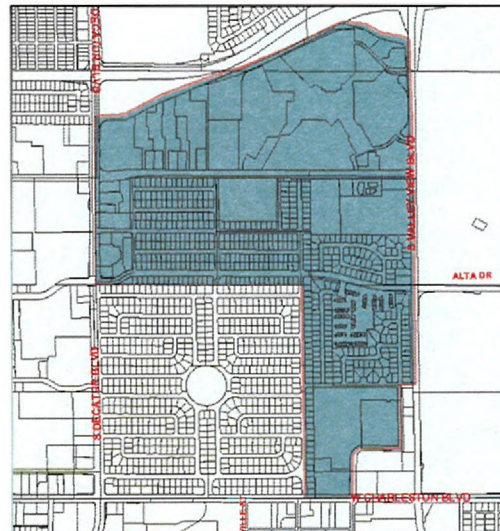
West Charleston Corridor Plan

- Trees: shade trees/no trees
- Lighting: add'l lighting for safety
- Medians: preserve access to businesses
- Transit: add'l turnouts, set shelters back from curb
- Development standards: control displays, illegal signage, protect residential



Meadows Walkable Community Plan

- Sidewalks: complete network, widen on Alta
- Trees: need additional shade on sidewalks
- Access: safe access to Meadows Mall
- Safety: concern about park, add'l lighting
- Traffic: speed on Alta, medians on Meadows
- Amenities: need grocery store



Village Square Walkable Community Plan

- Sidewalks: safer crosswalks
- Trees: add'l trees on Sahara, Ft. Apache
- Bike lanes: add'l dedicated lanes needed
- Access: controlled access gates to commercial
- Traffic: reduce speed
- Amenities: post office, add'l specialty grocery



Schedule

- July/August: complete draft plans
- September: meet with neighborhood associations
- October: public input meeting
- October/November: Planning Commission
