Minutes:

CHAIR TRUESDELL declared the Public Hearing open.

STEVE GEBEKE, Planning and Development, stated that beginning January 2011, the City of Las Vegas will be transitioning to a four-day work week for all but essential functions, with offices closed to the public on Fridays. Consequently, Fridays may no longer be considered for purposes of Computation of Time for certain actions to occur. The proposed change will have the effect of excluding Fridays, but will also exclude other days that City offices may be closed due to unforeseen events, such as inclement weather. It will also allow for the future transition back to a full five-day work week without the need to further amend this section of Title 19.

CHAIR TRUESDELL declared the Public Hearing closed.
