AN ORDINANCE TO UPDATE MUNICIPAL CODE PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND BUSINESS SERVICES, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Summary: Updates Municipal Code provisions pertaining to the Department of Finance and Business Services.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 18, Section 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.18.010: [Pursuant to the provisions of Section 3.130 of the Charter of the City of Las Vegas, there is hereby created a Department of Financial Management of the City. The head of the Department of Financial Management shall be the director of Financial Management.] Article III of the Charter of the City of Las Vegas requires the City Council to establish a department of financial management, to be headed by a director of financial management. The City Council hereby:

(A) Establishes the Department of Finance and Business Services as the City's department of financial management; and

(B) Designates the City's Chief Financial Officer as the Director of that Department.

SECTION 2: Title 2, Chapter 18, Sections 20 and 30, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, are hereby repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,

2 SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
3 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
4 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
