PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

At its meeting of July 7, 2010, the City Council is scheduled to approve the Historic Properties and Neighborhoods Preservation Plan Element of the Las Vegas 2020 Master Plan. This Plan element is intended to replace and supersede the previously-adopted Historic Properties Preservation Plan Element. This bill will merely formalize the adoption by ordinance.

Minutes:

COUNCILMAN BARLOW declared the Public Hearing open.

FLINN FAGG, Planning and Development, indicated the bill would address two changes that occurred during the 2009 Legislature session. It requires language relative to the protection and preservation of paleontological sites and adds a definition for historic neighborhoods. MR. FLAGG verified for COUNCILMAN BARLOW that this is not specific to the Ice Age Park but it facilitates the request. Assembly Bill 304 requires a definition for historic neighborhoods, and any neighborhood or structure older than 50 years may qualify for an historic designation.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW declared the Public Hearing closed.
