COUNCILMAN ROSS declared the Public Hearing open.

CITY CLERK BEVERLY K. BRIDGES explained that every Municipal election cycle, the Clark County Election Department reviews all precincts and ward boundaries. As per Nevada Revised Statutes, larger precincts are spread out when the population exceeds a certain amount of growth. Precincts in Wards 2, 4 and 6 were adjusted due to such growth and changes will reflect in the precinct map for the 2011 Municipal election.
