PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This bill will update Chapter 6.06 of the Municipal Code relating to privileged licenses. Included are modifications regarding changes to existing licenses, modifications that are designed to incorporate existing City practices. Also included are modifications that streamline the process of certain license-related approvals.

Minutes:

By way of reading the item, COUNCILMAN BARLOW declared the Public Hearing open.

FLINN FAGG, Director of Planning, and KAREN DUDDLESTEN, Business Licensing Manager, appeared before the board. MR. FAGG stated that the bill will implement several of changes. The first is to allow name and address changes to be handled administratively without requiring the item to go before the City Council, while significant changes such as a change in ownership will still be required to go before the City Council. The second is to remove child care licensing from the list of privileged licenses as the City no longer issues them and they are

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handled through the State. The third is to add a definition of moral turpitude to apply a narrow scope or clear definition when dealing with disciplinary actions regarding privileged licensing. The fourth revision is to change the requirements allowing the Director of Planning an opportunity to waive the investigation if one has been carried out within the past year. MR. FAGG also stated that the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (LVMPD) voiced some concerns with the investigative changes.

BRIAN O'CALLAGHAN, Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, stated when policy involving LVMPD is being written it should be coordinated with LVMPD. COUNCILMAN BARLOW stated he did not foresee the coordination causing a problem and MR. FAGG confirmed that he would work with the LVMPD.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW received confirmation from MR. FAGG that the red highlight is the proposed verbiage changes to be read before the Council.

COUNCILMAN COFFIN was originally a little uncomfortable with the pre-existing language, but the amendment offers a written policy that provides an established guideline.

By way of calling for a motion, COUNCILMAN BARLOW closed the Public Hearing closed.
