Minutes:

COUNCILMAN CORTEZ reminded the public of the time limitation for speaking and asked that they begin by stating their name for the record.

DICK GEYER, President of the Las Vegas 18b Arts District Neighborhood Association, stated the following three concerns and potential amendments for the bill: (1) that a boundary be imposed to prevent mobile vendors from encroaching on pre-existing permanent restaurants, (2) that mobile vendors should be required to seek permission of property owners before utilizing vacant or empty lots, and (3) that the ordinance clearly state guidelines for mobile vendors regarding their presence around special events and holidays.

CHIEF DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY VAL STEED confirmed for the Councilmen that this item does not allow for dialogue and that open discussion should be held while a specific item is open for discussion.
