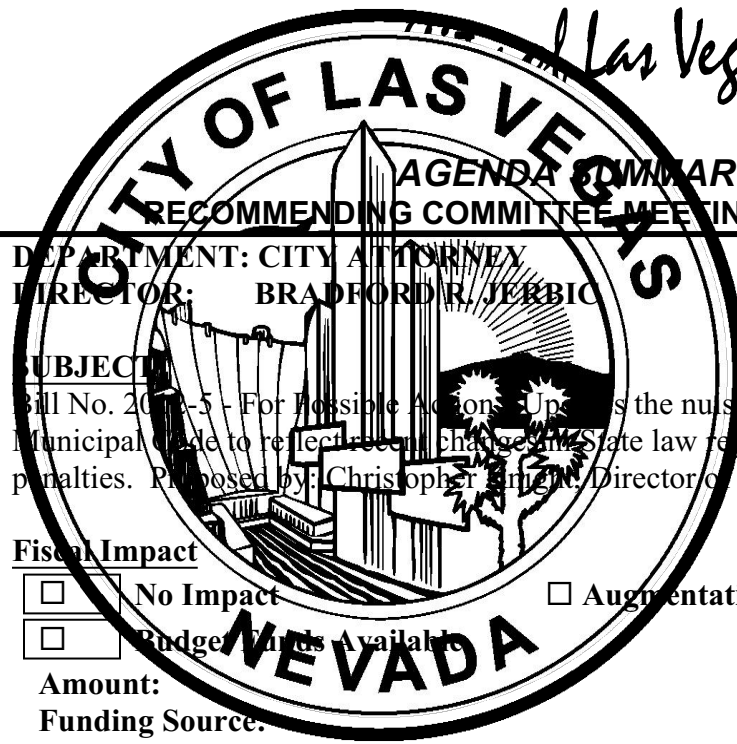

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

During its 2011 Session, the Nevada Legislature adopted Assembly Bill 360 on the subject of nuisance abatement proceedings. In particular, the bill revises provisions regarding notice periods and civil penalties applicable to such proceedings. This bill will conform the City's Code provisions to reflect the changes.
