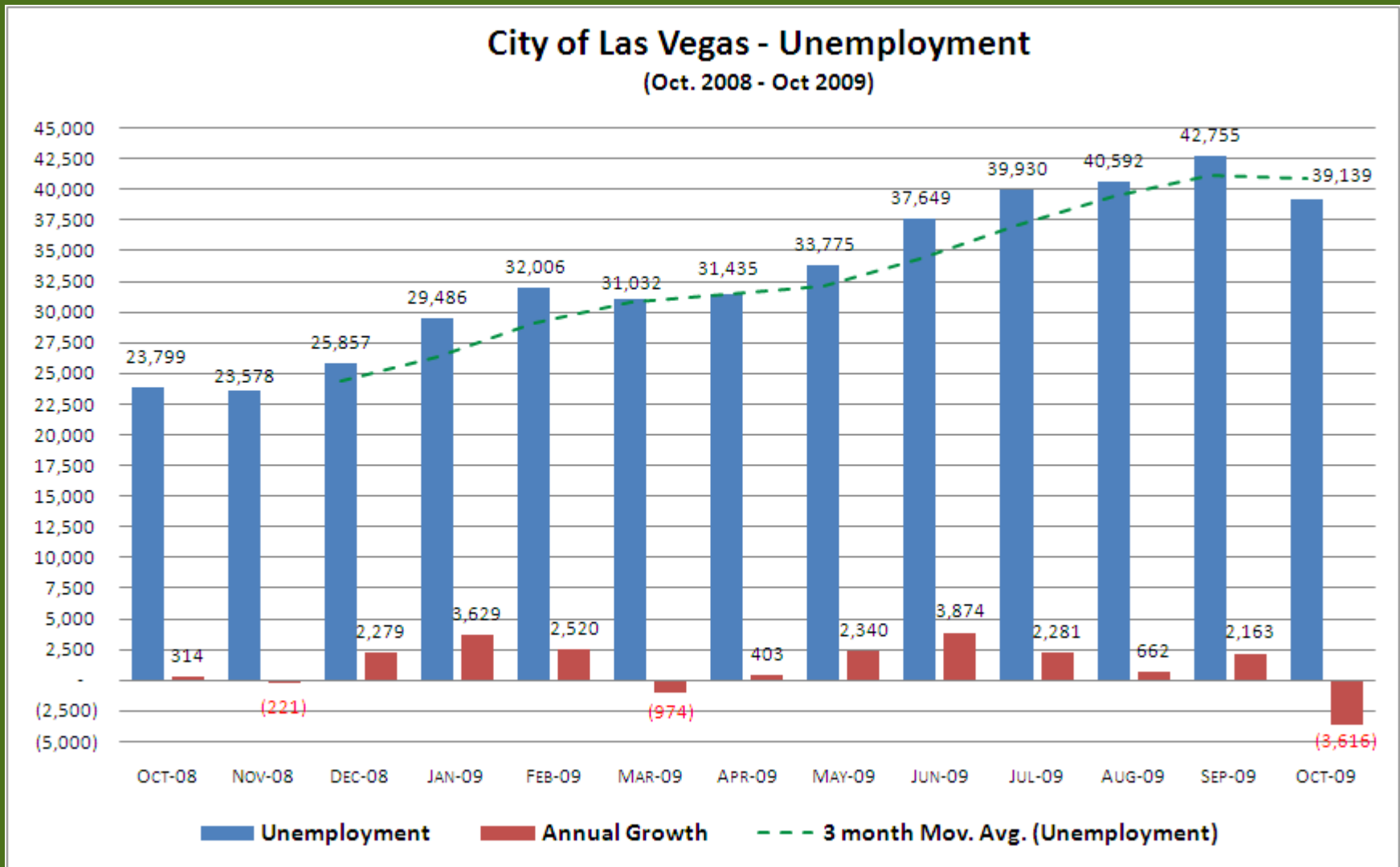

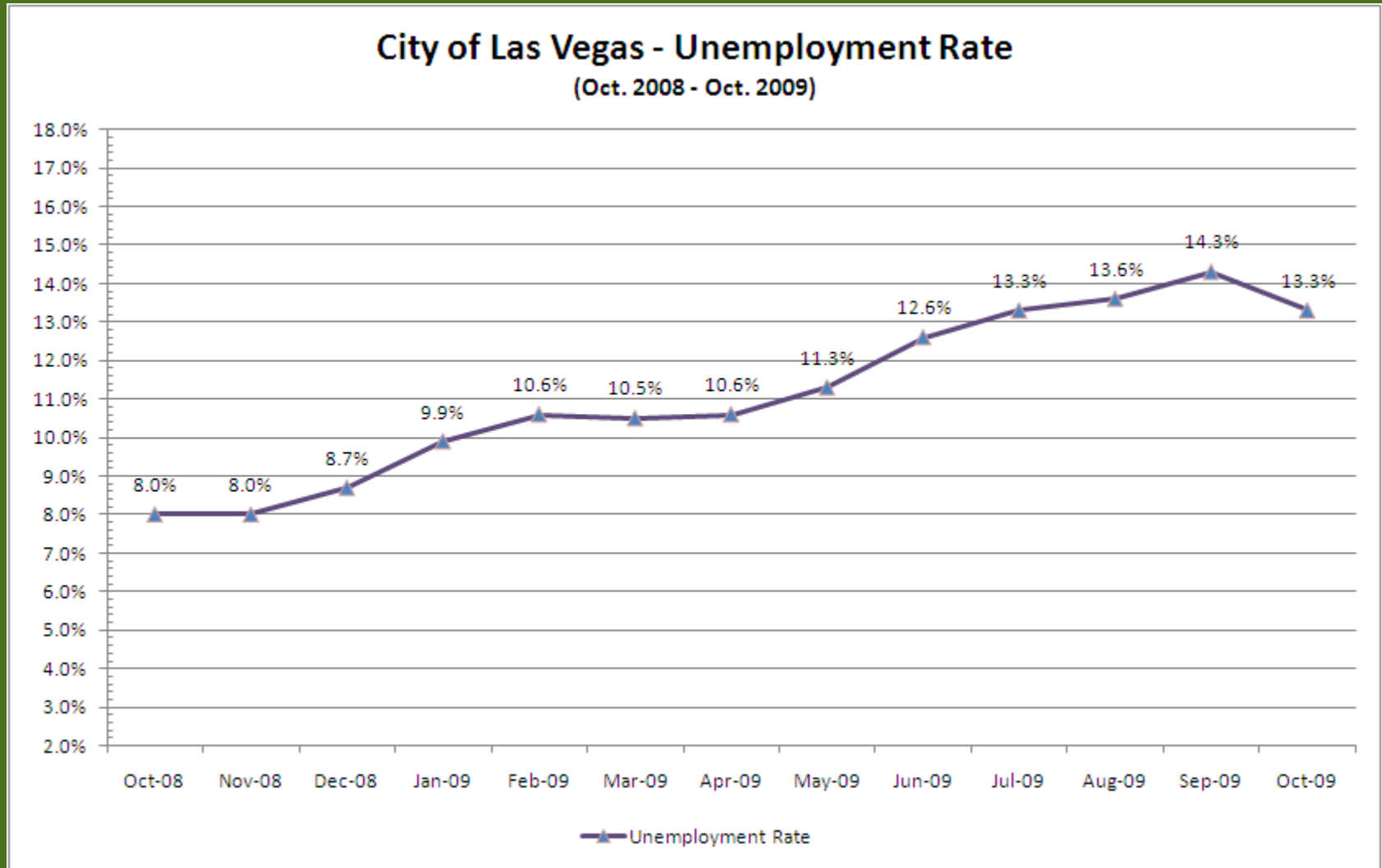

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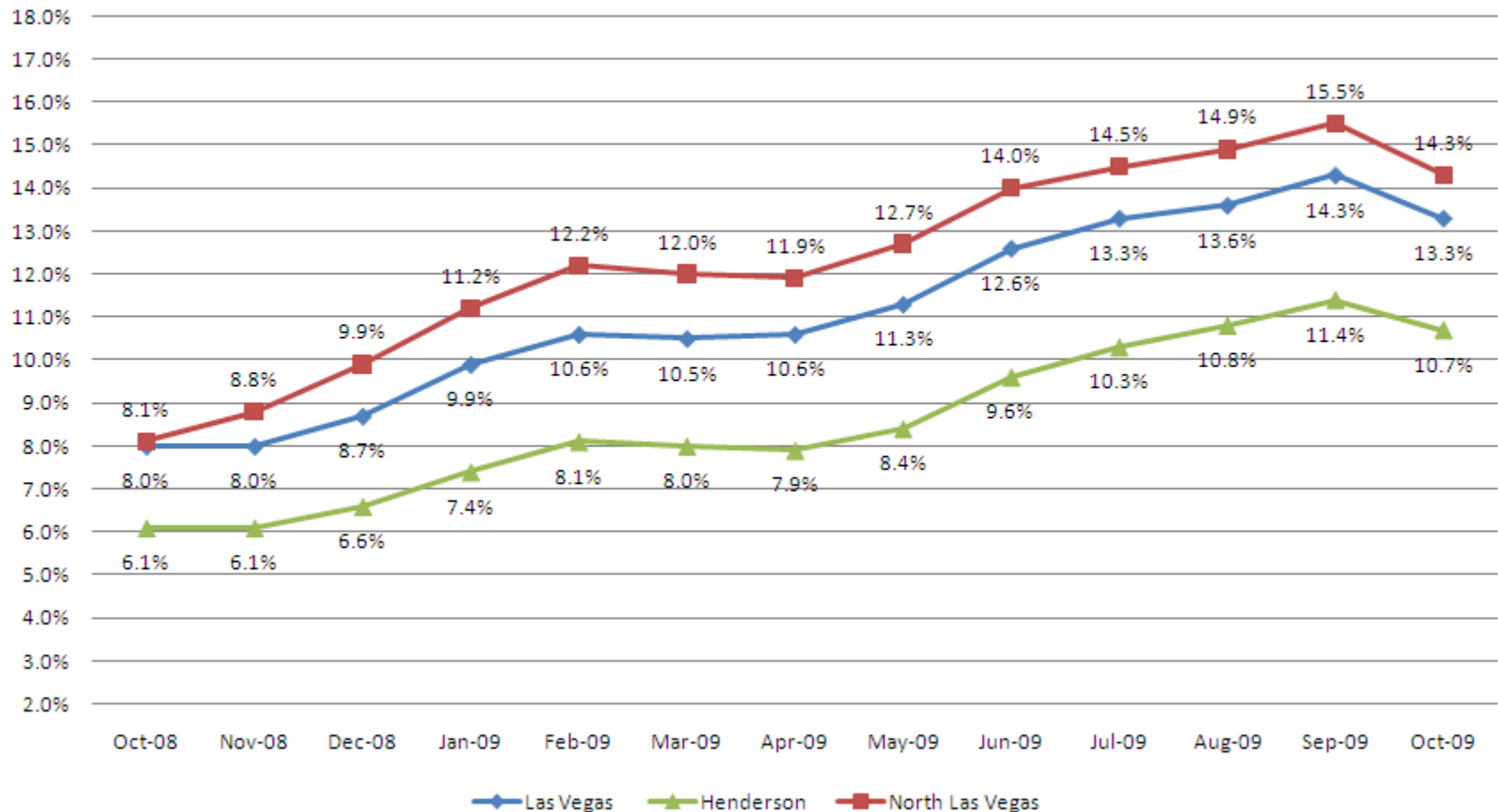

(Oct. 2008 - Oct. 2009)

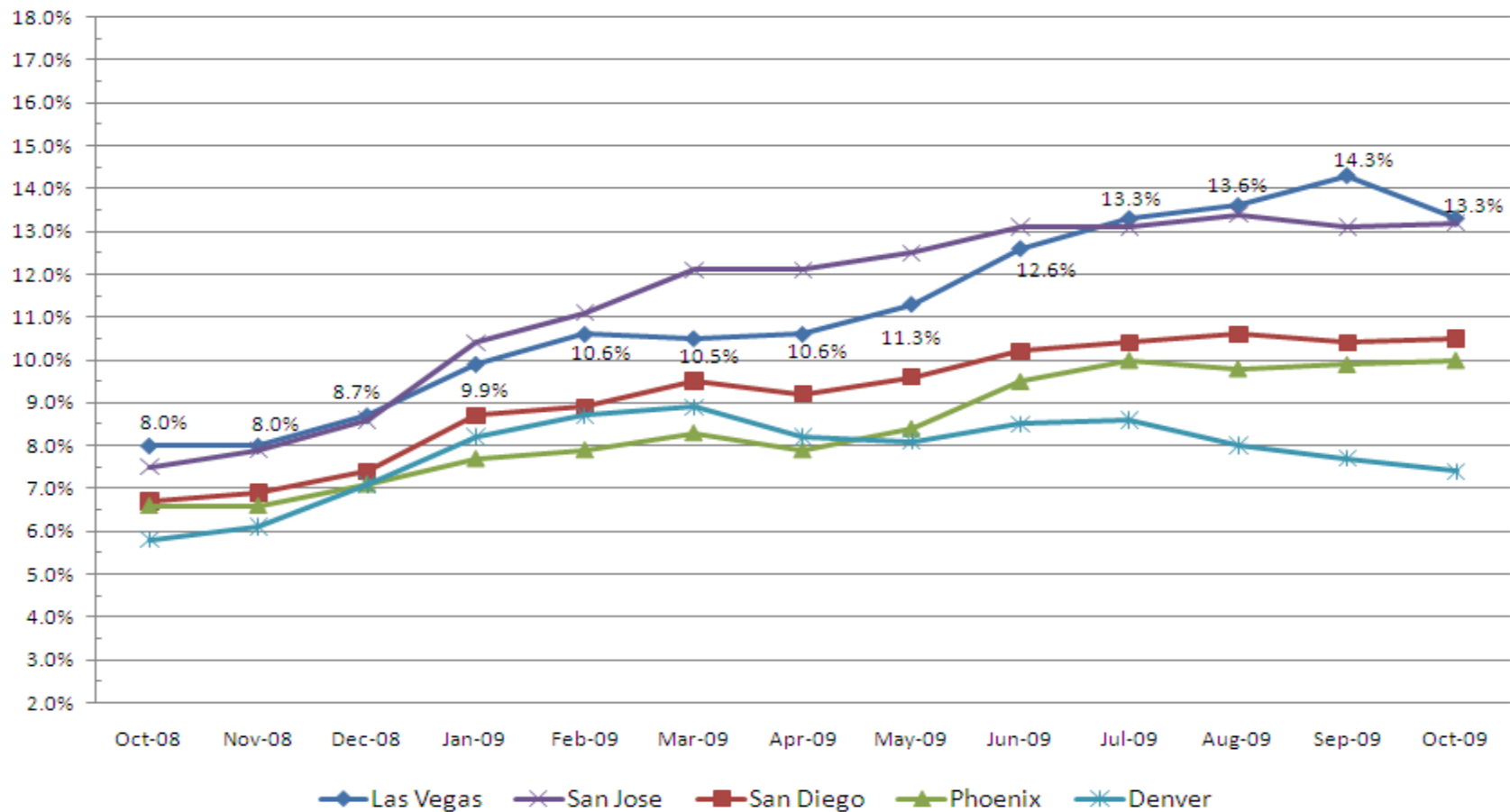

(Oct. 2008 - Oct. 2009)

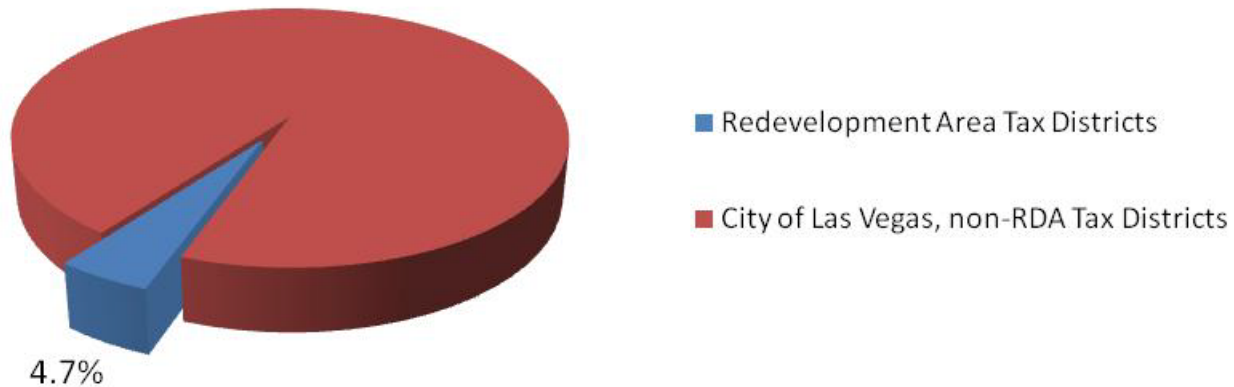

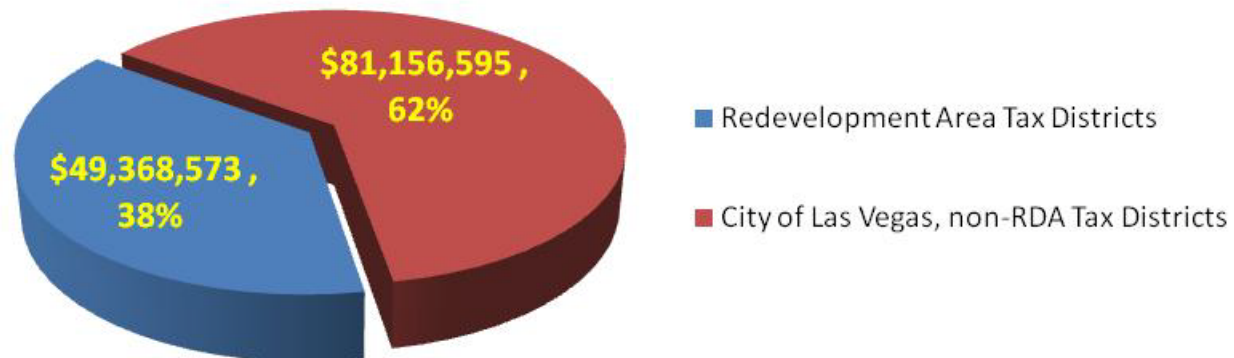

Impact on Jobs

Redevelopment Job Impact

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- Workforce in Redevelopment Area increased by 1,886 jobs, or an **annual increase of 2.7%**.
- Workforce in the city of Las Vegas decreased by 2,318 jobs, or an **annual decrease of 0.8%**.
- For projects under construction, there are an estimated 3,000 construction jobs and 900 permanent jobs.
