Minutes:

JUANITA CLARK, Chair of the Neighborhood Preservation, questioned the status of her request to have the Chairman read a portion of the minutes of Item 3 of the 12/2/2009 Special Joint City Council and Redevelopment Agency meeting and Item 50 of the 12/2/2009 City Council meeting. CHAIRMAN GOODMAN advised her that he did not receive such a request, but he seldom receives any of her requests before the meeting.

ANTHONY HODGES, Las Vegas resident, stated that holding the Redevelopment Agency meetings at different times does not give the public a chance to peak. This is a violation of the Open Meeting Law.

MEMBER WOLFSON verified with EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR ELIZABETH FRETWELL that the RDA agenda was posted last Thursday and made available on the City's website. Printed agendas are available before the meeting and a mailing list is available for those residents who prefer having it mailed. Meeting times are changed based upon how long the RDA meeting might last. MR. HODGES responded that years ago the meeting was held around noon, and he asked that a time be set and stay consistent.
