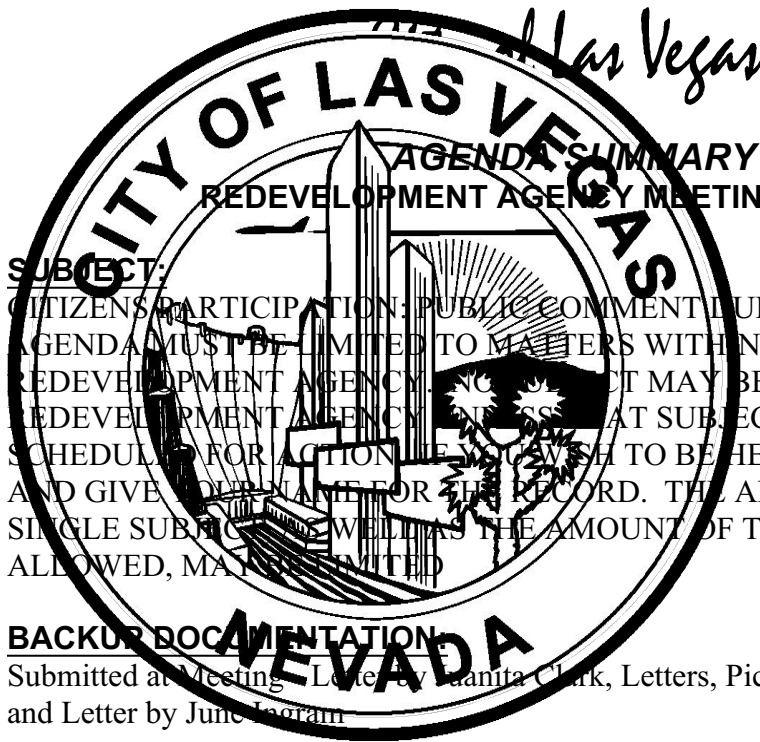




AGENDA SUMMARY PAGE
