Minutes:

KATHERINE DUNCAN was pleased that funds from the Redevelopment Agency, in her opinion, were not being used correctly and should be used for blighted areas. She believed the City was breaking the law, in that the appropriate percent of local residents were not being hired on various projects.

ANTHONY HODGES expressed concern when the Redevelopment Agency meeting time is changed. He appreciated the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's actions on a recent incident and was pleased to see that African American men were vindicated. He did not believe that CHAIR GOODMAN keeps his word.

Regarding MS. DUNCAN'S comments, MEMBER TARKANIAN requested documentation from staff verifying the City's conformance with the law. BILL ARENT, Director, Economic and Urban Development, obliged and noted that staff and the City Attorney's Office believe the City is in compliance.
