PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Dominick Vitale, dba Snick's Place, holds a Tavern License No. L16-00134-4-000843; a Restricted Gaming License No. G01-00410-4-000843; a Convention Hall Gaming Tax License No. C20-00410-7-000843; a Coin Amusement Machine License No. C08-01083-2-000843. He has operated the business as a nuisance by permitting repeated acts of sexual intercourse and other sexual related conduct to occur at his business, an establishment open to the public. The Respondent has admitted the violations in proceedings before the Nevada Gaming Commission entering into a stipulated agreement and order suspending the license and paying a \$50,000.00 fine to the State of Nevada.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council should conduct a hearing and render appropriate discipline, including, but not exclusively, revocation of all City-issued privileged business licenses.
