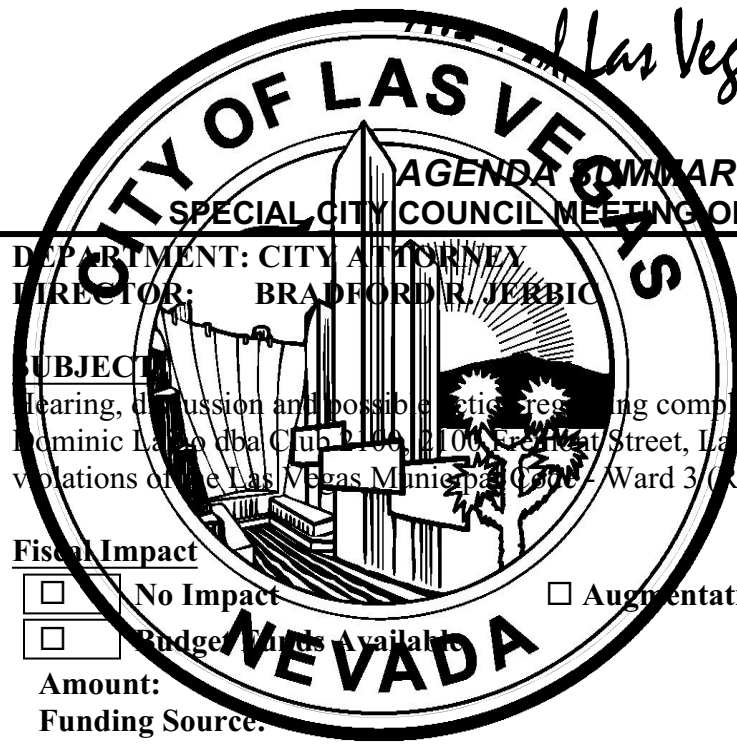

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Dominic Laino dba Club 2100, holds Tavern License No. L16-00302-4-000662; Retail Tobacco License No. C05-026. He has operated the business as a nuisance by advertising as an erotic dance establishment; creating an environment in which violence has occurred, requiring repeated calls/arrest by law enforcement; failure to adhere to work/health card and other employment/business activity record compilations; and, operating entertainment activities at the business on nights other than the one day per week as conditioned by the Council [Sundays only].

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council should conduct a hearing and render appropriate discipline, including, but not exclusively, revocation of all City-issued privileged business licenses.

D. Live entertainment restricted to Saturday night between 10:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m. Live entertainment shall be limited to DJ only.

E. All other nights - no form of live entertainment allowed, specifically:

- no DJ
- no amateur contests
- no deceptive advertising
- no karaoke
- no raffles

F. Only entertainment allowable shall be pre-recorded music played on jukebox, radio, CD or victrola.

G. Business may be closed by Manager of Business Services for any violation of condition(s). No requirement for notice of appeal, filing of disciplinary complaint or hearing, except a hearing shall be held at next available meeting of the City Council as decided by Manager.
