COUNCILMAN BROWN called forward Coaches GREG GOERGIAN and GARY HANNIG to honor the Meadows School AA Boys Basketball Team, which has won the State championship four years in a row. COACH GOERGIAN introduced the team members and stated that these players are champions on the basketball court and in the classroom. They will be a positive influence in their communities. After nine years, he is leaving the Meadows School, and it has been an honor to work with such great young men. COUNCILMAN BROWN presented a Certificate of Accomplishment to COACH HANNIG.

ADDITIONAL RECOGNITIONS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS:

DOUG KARAFKA, the Clean Water Coalition, and PAUL KAJKOWSKI, Director of Public Works, and DAVID MENDENHALL, Manager of the Environmental Division, joined COUNCILMAN BROWN, who read a Proclamation declaring May 2007 as Pain in the Drain Awareness Month. MR. KAJKOWSKI stated that the national program is aimed at getting the message out to no further pollute the drainage system. And the best way of doing that is by not putting certain chemicals in the sewer system, because the treatment process cannot remove those pollutants. MR. KARAFKA said the program is high-profile and very important. MR. MENDENHALL showed some receptacles that can be used to discard grease, which is better than putting it in the sewer system. The receptacles can be obtained from Public Works.

Before consideration of Item 11, COUNCILMAN BROWN welcomed the William Lummis Elementary School Student Council, the members of which would be sitting with the City Council for a portion of the meeting. They introduced themselves and stated their position with the Lummis Council.
