**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

On August 29, 2005, Hurricane Katrina caused widespread devastation along the central Gulf Coast states. Cities such as New Orleans, LA, Mobile, AL and Gulfport, MS bore the brunt of Katrinas force. In response to the Katrina Disaster, the city of Las Vegas (Neighborhood Services) entered into a partnership with the HACLV to provide housing assistance for Katrina Evacuees that found their way to Las Vegas. On October 19, 2005, the City Council approved the allocation of \$1,000,000 in Low Income Housing Trust Fund (LIHTF) and Redevelopment Set-Aside funds (RDA) and assigned the HACLV the responsibility of administering the Katrina Victims Tenant Based Rental Assistance Program. Housing Assistance was provided to over 100 evacuees for a total of \$311,294.

**CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF: MAY 16, 2007**

STEPHEN HARSIN, Director of Neighborhood Services, went over the information under the Purpose/Background section.

CARL ROWE, Executive Director, and DOLORES SAWYER, Housing Programs Director, BRENDA FONSECA, Housing Programs Manager, and FATHER DAVE CASSEGLIO, Chairman, Las Vegas Housing Authority, were present. MS. SAWYER gave a detailed PowerPoint presentation, a copy of which is made a part of the minutes, to outline the efforts in the Katrina Evacuees Program.

MS. SAWYER thanked the Council, City, staff, the Housing Authority Board and HACLV for their contributions in making Las Vegas' Section 8 program one of the best, for which the Housing Authority received an award from the National Association of Redevelopment. She gave the plaque to the Mayor.

MAYOR GOODMAN noted that the Las Vegas Housing Authority took a lot of heat and was the subject of a lot of criticism but MR. ROWE turned it around completely and it is moving forward.
