MAYOR GOODMAN declared the Public Hearing open on Items 102 and 103.

He requested clarification on Condition 4, relative to test driving in the neighborhood. He confirmed there will be a specific drive course along Rainbow Boulevard and Sahara Avenue for test driving.

MARGO WHEELER, Director of Planning and Development, read the amendment to Condition 4 into the record.

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN commented that this request is a wonderful opportunity for revitalization for the subject shopping center. In addition, the applicant has been a good neighbor and an excellent business community member at their other location on Eastern Avenue and Karen Avenue.
