Minutes:

MAYOR GOODMAN invited FIRE AND RESCUE CHIEF MIKE MYERS, CLARK COUNTY FIRE CAPTAIN SCOTT STRAILY and JEREMY HAUSER, Clark County School District (CCSD) Associate Superintendent of Operations, to the podium to discuss the Great Nevada Shakeout. On Thursday, October 18, 2012 at 10:18 a.m. approximately half a million Nevadans will participate in the Great Nevada Shakeout emergency earthquake drill. The Mayor specifically thanked CAPTAIN STRAILY for being instrumental in getting things started in Las Vegas and presented him with a proclamation.

PAUL GERNER, Clark County School District Chief of Facilities, explained he was standing in for MR. HAUSER, who sent his regrets for not being able to attend the meeting. MR. GERNER expressed appreciation for the great proclamation and, in response to MAYOR GOODMAN, discussed what it means to stop, drop and cover.

CHIEF MYERS recognized the numerous agencies and organizations involved in the Great Nevada Shakeout and had CAPTAIN STRAILY say a few words about how the concept for the drill was born.

MAYOR GOODMAN encouraged everyone in the Valley to participate and be prepared for emergencies.
