**RECOMMENDING COMMITTEE MEETING OF: APRIL 16, 2013**

DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY STEED clarified that there is a new Section 7 in the First Amendment that will serve to maintain a record that certain businesses will be grandfathered in with their current business license category.

COUNCILMAN BEERS thanked MS. DUDDLESTEN for working with staff and industry representatives.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW announced that this bill will be eligible for adoption on May 1, 2013.
