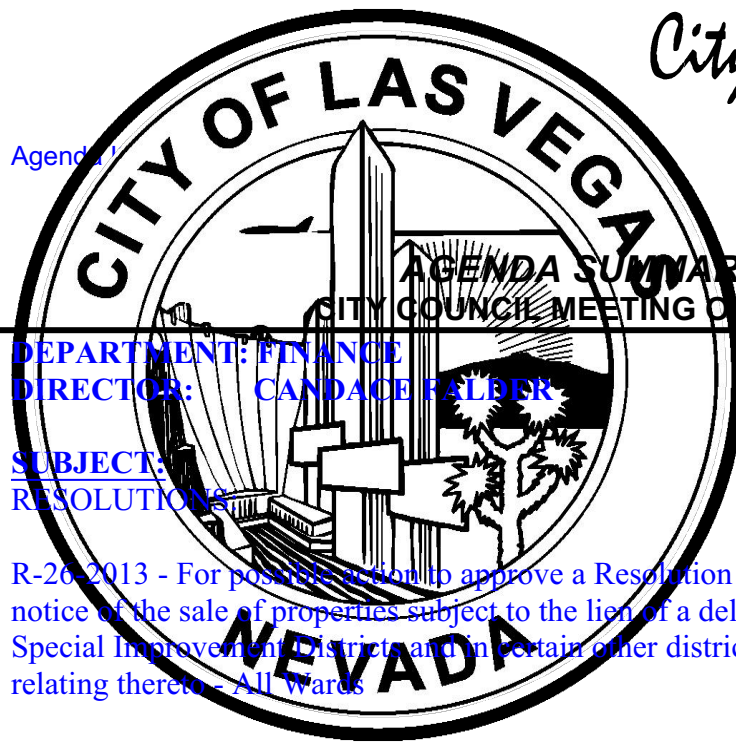

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

NRS 271.545 states that when an assessment or installment relating to a special improvement district becomes delinquent, the City shall direct the City Treasurer to give notice of the sale of the property or properties subject to the lien of a delinquent installment or the entire assessment if the governing body has exercised its option to cause the whole amount of the unpaid principal to become due and payable.
