PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

In order to receive federal and state funds for housing, homeless, and community development activities, the City of Las Vegas must submit an Action Plan to HUD no later than May 15, 2013. The Draft Action Plan outlines activities that will be undertaken by the City of Las Vegas for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014. Funding sources include CDBG, ESG, HOME and HOPWA funds from HUD; and HOME funds from the State of Nevada.

Staff recommends that Council approve the submittal of the City of Las Vegas 2013-2014 Action Plan to HUD, including consideration of public comment as required by HUD.
