Minutes:

STANTON WILKERSON, President of Harrison House, an organization that renovates historic homes used by African-American entertainers during Las Vegas period of segregation. He invited the Mayor and City Council to the Emancipation Proclamation celebration, which will be held March 24 through March 30. A portion of the program will be dedicated to Nevada's 150th State birthday. CHAIR GOODMAN suggested MR. WILKERSON contact KCLV Channel 2 to possibly making a public announcement. MEMBER BARLOW confirmed with MR. WILKERSON that the Harrison House is located at 1001 F Street. A series of events have been scheduled which includes a community clean-up of F Street and adjoining neighborhoods; storytelling; a dedication to the Moulin Rouge agreement, which ended the practice of discrimination in hotels located downtown and the Las Vegas Strip; a golf tournament fundraiser and a street fest to be held on F Street with vendors to provide health information, a job fair, arts and crafts, and a barbeque.
