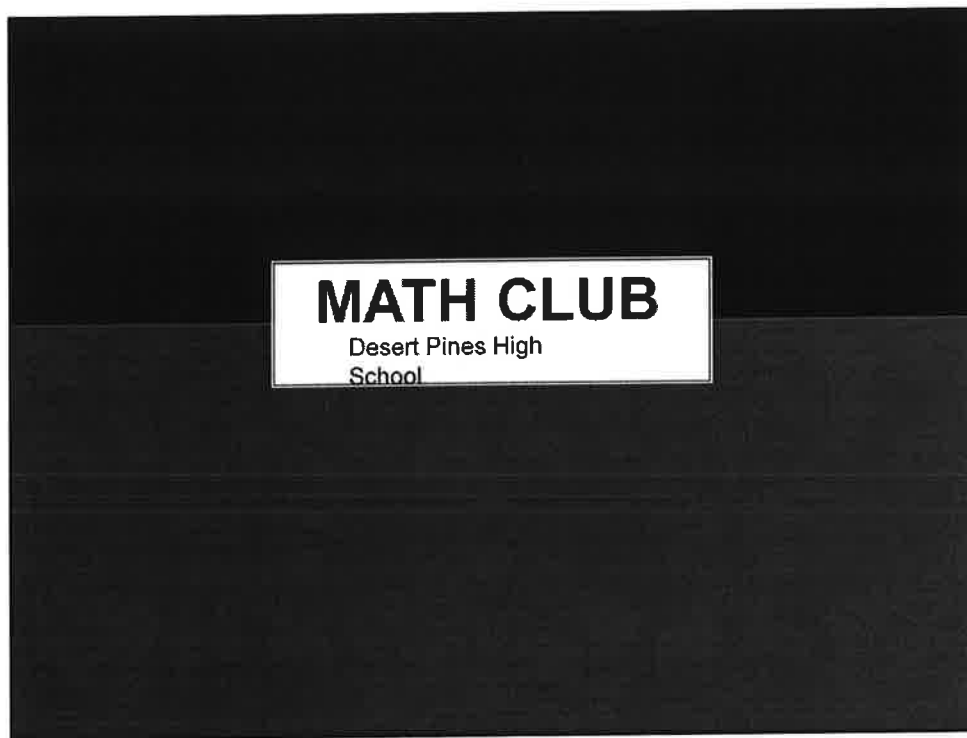

These tutoring sessions generally last one and half to two hours.

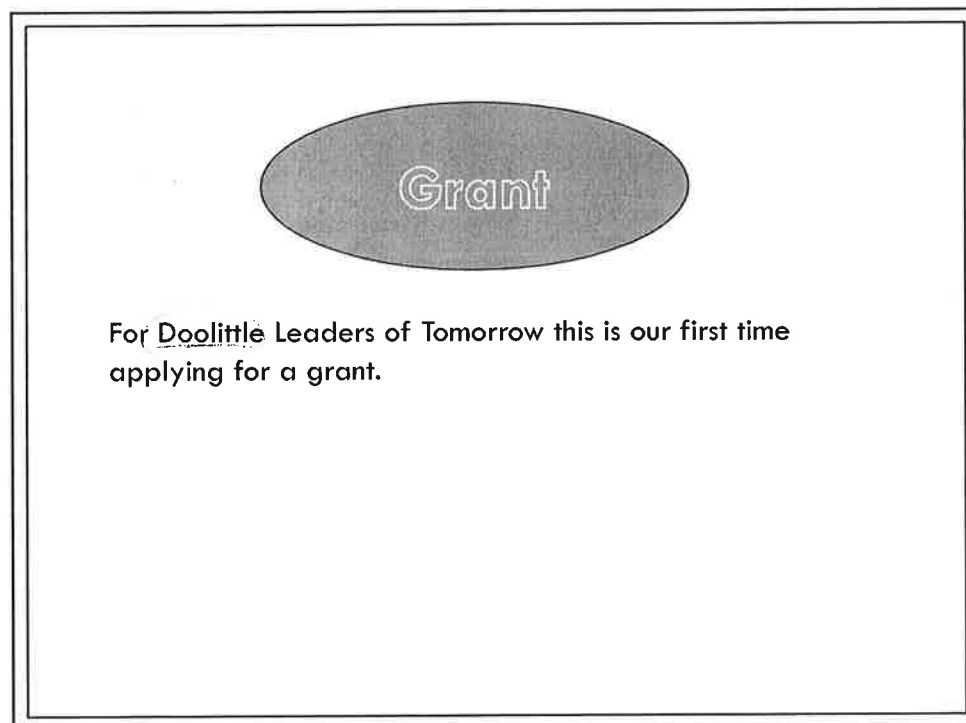
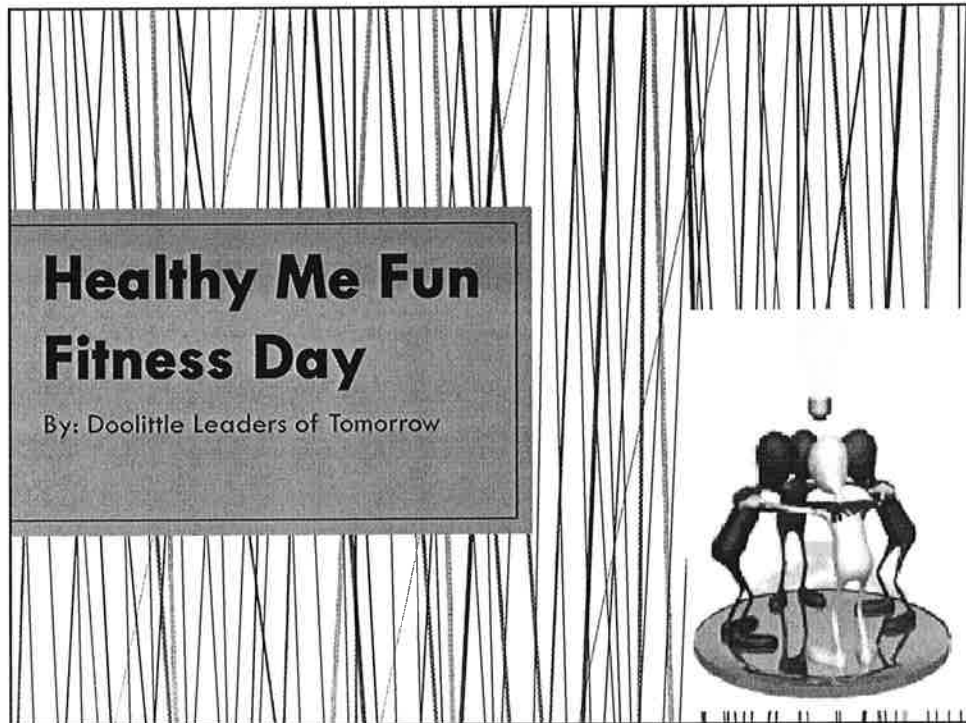

United we stand, Divided we fall

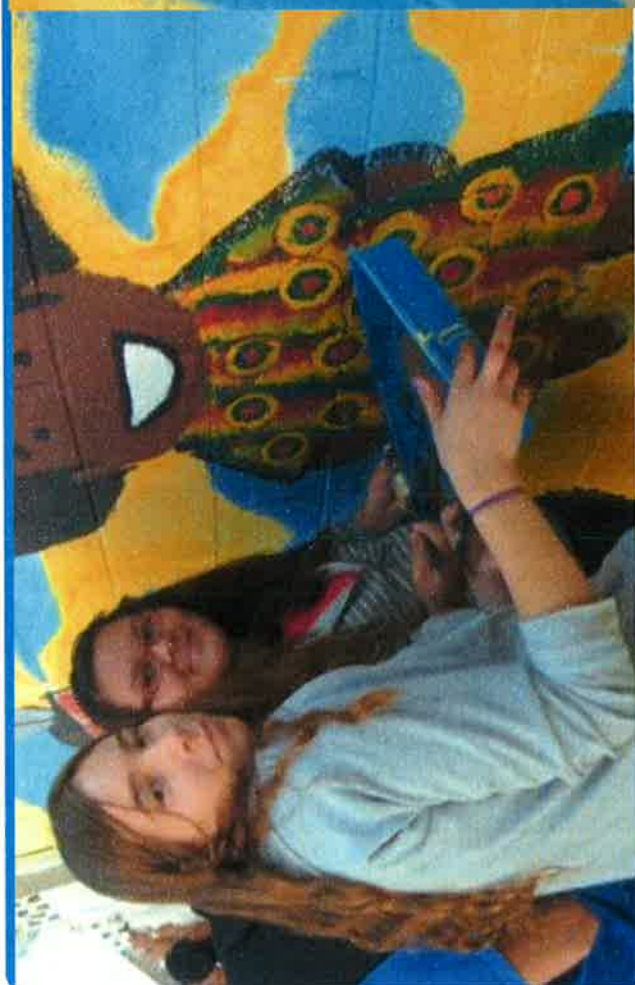
- * We first developed the idea that we wanted to make a permanent impact in the community, but also wanted to combine the locals teens and our artistic ideas

Helps the local teens converge and contribute their own unique abilities

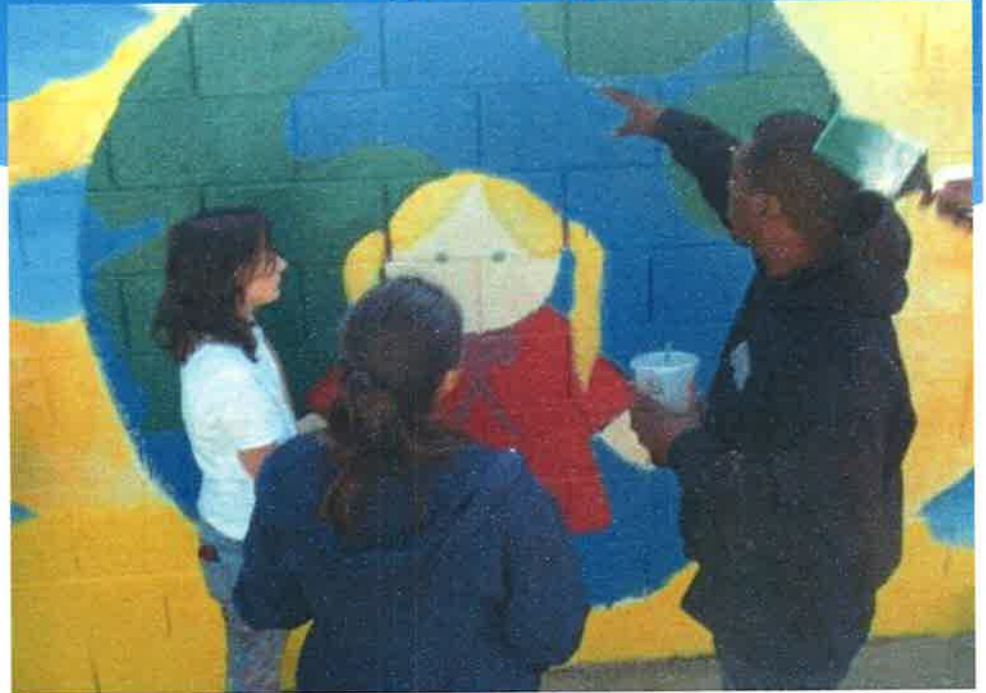

This prom is an opportunity for senior citizens to attend a light-hearted event reflecting the fond memories of their adolescent years in a themed party environment.



Who Will Benefit from the Speakeasy?

Seniors:

- They will have a change in environment.
- Depression rates among senior citizens are higher than those of any other age group. Depressive symptoms occur in about 15 percent of seniors living within the community and in 25 percent of seniors within a nursing home. By hosting this event we hope to lighten the moods of those who are included in this statistic.

Who Will Benefit from the Speakeasy (Cont.)

Inspiration

Senior Year to Senior Citizen
