3 AN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT ISSUED UNDER LVMC CHAPTER
4 12.02 TO FUNCTION AS A TEMPORARY SIGN PERMIT AND TEMPORARY SIGN CERTIFICATE
5 UNDER THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES, AND TO
6 PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Summary: Allows a special event permit issued
under LVMC Chapter 12.02 to function as a
temporary sign permit and temporary sign
certificate under the Unified Development Code
under certain circumstances.

9 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS
10 FOLLOWS:

11 SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 6289 and the Unified Development Code adopted as Title
12 19 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, are hereby amended as set forth
13 in Section 2 of this Ordinance. The amendment is deemed to be an amendment to both Ordinance No.
14 6289 and the Unified Development Code adopted as Title 19.

15 SECTION 2: Title 19, Chapter 16, Section 170, Subsection (A), is hereby amended to
16 read as follows:

17 A. Procedures

18 Except as otherwise provided in this Subsection (A), [The] the procedures contained in this Section shall
19 govern the application for, and issuance of, all temporary sign permits under this Title. In the case of
20 special event signs referred to in Section 19.08.120(G)(1)(b), a special event permit issued pursuant to
21 LVMC Chapter 12.02 that addresses such signage for a particular event shall serve as the temporary sign
22 permit and the temporary sign certificate for that signage that otherwise would be required by this Section
23 19.16.170 and by Section 19.08.120(G)(1)(b).

24 SECTION 3: For purposes of Section 2.100(3) of the City Charter, Section 19.16.170 is
25 deemed to be a subchapter rather than a section.

26 SECTION 4: The Department of Planning is authorized and directed to incorporate into

1 the Unified Development Code the amendment set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance.

2 SECTION 5: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or
3 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or
4 ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or
5 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City
6 of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph,
7 sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections,
8 subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

9 SECTION 6: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared to
10 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is required
11 or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of
12 such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon
13 conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of
14 not more than six months, or by any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation
15 of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.
