Minutes:

ANDRE HAINES, Las Vegas resident, read an announcement about the Valentines Ball and Gala at the Mt. Charleston Resort on 2/15/2014.

JOEL WEBER, Las Vegas resident, spoke about the traffic problem near Walter Jacobson Elementary School and gave details of an incident in which his wife rescued a child in the crosswalk who was almost hit by a vehicle. Thereafter, he and his wife started volunteering as crossguards. Complaints were made to the School District about them, and they were told that they could not assist because of the potential liability. He contacted the School District police and the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department only to find out that there is nothing that he can do. CHAIR GOODMAN asked him to contact MEMBER BEER'S office and set up a meeting that she will also attend in order to try to find a solution. MEMBER BEERS referred him to JOHN BEAR of his office to make an appointment. MEMBER TARKANIAN asked MR. WEBER to contact ROBIN MUNIER of her office who works closely with kids and has a lot of contacts.
