COMMISSIONER SCHLOTTMAN commented on the substantial improvements the City has made relative to connectivity ratios and its urban sprawl plan, although there are some smaller developments, including within his community, where connectivity is an issue in establishing a walkable community.

COMMISSIONER BONAR recalled some 30 years ago his efforts in promoting what some individuals in the planning industry called urban sprawl and in places like Summerlin, the City has welcomed it.
