Bill No. 2014-23 Amends LVMC 65.1285 to provide that the owner of an establishment adjacent to a pedestrian mall that is licensed to conduct nonrestricted gaming and is authorized to sell alcoholic beverages pursuant to a tavern license may operate up to two bars upon the adjacent pedestrian mall under specified circumstances. PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Last year the City Council adopted a provision authorizing the owner of an establishment adjacent to a pedestrian mall that holds a license for nonrestricted gaming and a tavern license at the same location to operate a temporary or permanent bar upon the mall. A follow-up bill was proposed to clarify that an establishment could operate more than one such bar, but that bill was not adopted. This bill will expressly provide that such an establishment may operate up to two bars upon the adjacent pedestrian mall under the circumstances and conditions described in the bill.

RECOMMENDATION:

This bill should be submitted to a Recommending Committee for review, hearing and recommendation to the City Council for final action.
