**PRESENTATION BY THE SOUTHERN NEVADA CHAPTER OF THE INTERNATIONAL CODE COUNCIL**

Minutes:

MAYOR GOODMAN invited CHRIS KNIGHT, Director of Building and Safety, to the podium who recalled past proposed legislation dealing with a requirement to have barriers around existing swimming pools on residential properties. This proposed bill did not pass and given the strong concerns of the Southern Nevada building officials, along with the Southern Nevada Chapter of the International Code Council (SNICC), a program was implemented that extends \$1,500 to each community, which is to be used for swimming lessons for children under four years of age.

DAVID GOLDSTEIN, Southern Nevada Chapter of the International Code Council, presented the City Council with a check for the amount of \$1,500. Yearly, approximately 60 swim lessons for children are offered through the City's Park, Recreation and Neighborhood Services Department. Over the years, the SNICC has provided over \$70,000 toward swimming grant programs and was proud of a fact book from Clark County Health District indicating that the number of drowning in the Valley is at the lowest it has been in a long time.
